

Freshman: Applicants who are currently attending their final year or who have graduated from high school and who have not attended a college (dual enrollment and summer immediately following high school graduation are excluded).

Transfer: Applicants who have enrolled for any credit level course at another college or university after graduating from high school.

International Freshman: Applicants who are citizens of a country other than the United States who meet the qualifications listed for freshman. (If you are a Permanent Resident of the US you are not considered an International applicant.) Additional requirements may apply to international applicants.

International Transfer: Applicants who are citizens of a country other than the United States who meet the qualifications listed for transfer. (If you are a Permanent Resident of the US you are not considered an International applicant.) Additional requirements may apply to international applicants.

Transient: Applicants who wish to take classes at MSU and transfer that MSU academic credit back to their primary college or university. Transient enrollment eligibility is only good for one semester. Applicants should choose the Transfer Application type and respond “Yes” to the question ‘Are you applying for admission only as a transient student?’

Non-Degree: Applicants who are at least 21 years old who wish to take classes as prerequisites for another program or who wish to take non-degree courses for self-improvement or job enhancement. Choose ‘Special Non-Degree’ as the program of interest in the admission information section of the application.

Re-Admission: If you have previously attended MSU as an undergraduate student but have remained un-enrolled for a full term (excluding summer) you should apply for readmission through the Office of the Registrar. (If you enrolled and withdrew for a fall or spring term, you should contact the department of your major to continue your enrollment in the subsequent term.)
